STATEMENT ON THE DEATH OF A LEVEL 300 STUDENT

Management and the entire student body of the Evangelical Presbyterian University College (EPUC) received the sad news of the death of one of our students, Miss Elizabeth Yesutor Akpalu on Tuesday, 8th March, 2021. We convey our heartfelt condolences to the bereaved family on this great loss.

Management's attention was drawn to the issue of assault meted out to the deceased on a number of occasions by her boyfriend, Mr Philip Ceaser Kumah, who is a level 200 student. We are informed that the police is handling the criminal aspect of this case. Without prejudice to the ongoing case with the police, Management has put in place a fact-finding committee to look into the allegations and report for further action. This is in line with our policy on discipline.

Management assures the public that appropriate action will be taken based on the findings and laid down regulations. We reiterate our resolve as an institution to ensure that our students remain disciplined at all times. This has been our hallmark over the years and shall be observed at all times. We are not oblivious of the pain of this loss on the immediate family and EPUC. We however appeal for calm in these trying times while the matter of the alleged assault is dealt with. May the soul of the departed rest in peace.
